(construction services), Manassas, VA, a company that owns five (5) subsidiaries active in the steel industry, including Williams Bridge Company, one of the largest fabricators of steel plate for bridge structures in the Mid-Atlantic region. He continues to serve on the Board of Directors of Williams Industries, Inc. He is also Managing Partner and principal owner of Structural Concrete Products, LLC, Woodbridge, VA, which operates a drilling division engaged in the NC, VA, MD and DC markets.
