

Military Bowl presented by Northrop Grumman: Military Family Gameday Experience Program

Official Rules

No purchase or payment of any kind is necessary to enter or win.

1. HOW TO ENTER

- a. These rules govern the Military Bowl presented by Northrop Grumman "Military Family Gameday Experience" (the "Program") being conducted by WJFK-FM (the "Station" beginning Friday November 18, 2011 at approximately 5:00 p.m. Eastern Time ("ET") and ending on Friday, December 23, 2011 at approximately 5:00 p.m. ET.
- b. To participate in the Program, you may nominate each family one time. A listener may attempt to enter as many times as they wish according to the terms set forth in each of the below methods. A total of seven (7) winners will be selected from the Program.
- c. **ONLINE ENTRY:** To participate in the Program, you must email nominate@militarybowl.org or mail to 1200 New Hampshire Ave, Washington, D.C. 20036 Attn: Military Family Gameday Experience Program. Nomination must include your first name and last name, complete address, city, state, zip code, telephone number, and a valid email address. If you wish to nominate anonymously, please specify and contact information will not be shared with winning family. Entries **will** carry over week to week. A "week" in this Program is considered Friday to Thursday. The weekly winner will be selected at random no later than 5:00 p.m. ET each Wednesday following the preceding entry week, with the first drawing on November 25, 2011. Only one email entry per person and one internet entry per email address is permitted. Entries submitted will not be acknowledged or returned. Use of any device to automate entry is prohibited. Proof of submission of an entry shall not be deemed proof of receipt by Station. The Military Bowl is not responsible for entries not received due to difficulty accessing the internet, service outage or delays, computer difficulties and other technological problems. Listeners need not be present or listening at the time of the drawing in order to receive tickets.
- d. **ON-AIR ENTRY:** On-air entries will be entered into the general pool of candidates only after email with contact info has been submitted from WJFK to the Military Bowl. On-air entries are no more likely to win than email or mailed entries. The Station is not responsible for telephone service outages, delays, busy signals, equipment malfunctions and any other technological difficulties that may prevent an individual from completing his/her telephone call. Listeners to the online stream may participate in on-air entries.

2. ELIGIBILITY RESTRICTIONS

- a. The Program is open to all persons who are 18 years of age or older and who reside in the Washington DC Arbitron Market Area and adjacent counties. Employees of Station, its licensee, the licensee's parent, subsidiary and affiliated entities, Station's advertising and promotional agencies, its participating sponsors, other radio stations in the DC metropolitan area, the members of their immediate families (spouse, parents, sibling or child) and those living in the same household of each (whether related or not), are ineligible to enter or win. This Program is subject to all applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations and is void where prohibited. Employees of the Military Bowl, the members of their immediate families, and those living in the same household of each are ineligible to win.
- b. All nominations and eventual winners of the Program must be able to attend game or will be awarded to another nominee.
- c. For this Program only, all qualifiers who meet other eligibility restrictions will be eligible to win despite other Station contests won during this Program period.
- d. The winner must provide valid government-issued photo identification and provide their complete address, date of birth and phone number to claim a prize.
- e. Entrants are required to provide truthful information and the Military Bowl will reject and delete any entry that it discovers to be false or fraudulent. The Military Bowl will disqualify any entry from individuals who do not meet the eligibility requirements. The Military Bowl will also delete any entry knowingly received from persons under the age of 13 in compliance with the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act.

3. PRIZES

- a. Seven (7) prizes will be awarded in this Program. The prizes consist of the following: Four (4) tickets (\$55 seating level), one (1) parking pass, and four (4) field-level access passes for post-game trophy presentation. The Approximate Retail Value ("ARV") of each prize is \$350. The winners will be solely responsible for all taxes and all other fees and expenses, not specified herein associated with the receipt and use of prizes. All other costs not specifically stated herein as being awarded are the responsibility of winner.
- b. Prior to prize fulfillment, the winner must execute and return any required affidavit of eligibility and/or liability/publicity release within ten (10) days of winner selection. Once this is complete and verified by the Military Bowl, the winner may pick up prize from 1200 New Hampshire Ave, Washington, D.C. 20036 by December 23, 2011. In the event that a prize is mailed to the winner, winner assumes the risk of its loss.

- c. There is no substitution, transfer or cash equivalent for prizes, except that the Military Bowl may, at its sole discretion, substitute prizes of comparable value. The prizes are expressly limited to the item(s) listed above and unless otherwise expressly specified, do not include taxes, gratuities or any other expenses. Other restrictions may apply.

4. WINNER SELECTION AND NOTIFICATION

- a. Decisions of the Military Bowl management with respect to the Program are final.
- b. One (1) prize winner will be selected each week throughout the course of the Program as described in Section 1 of these Official Rules.
- c. All winners must be able to attend the 2011 Military Bowl presented by Northrop Grumman on December 28, 2011 at RFK Stadium in Washington, D.C.
- d. Winners will be announced each week on the Station Fridays. Winners will also be notified via a phone call and email prior to being announced.
- e. Odds of winning a prize depend on number of eligible entries received according to the terms set forth in Section 1 above.
- f. Winners must execute and return any required affidavit of eligibility and/or liability/publicity release within ten (10) days of winning or prize will be forfeited and another winner will be selected at random. If a potential winner cannot be contacted, fails to sign and return the required affidavit of eligibility and/or liability/publicity release within the required time period, or if a prize is returned as undeliverable, the potential winner forfeits the prize.

5. CONDITIONS

- a. By participating in the Program, the winner agrees to have the winner's name, voice and likeness used in any advertising or broadcasting material relating to the Program without additional financial or other compensation, and, where legal, to sign a publicity release confirming such consent prior to acceptance of the prize.
- b. Prior to awarding any prize or prize certificate, the Military Bowl, in its sole discretion, may require Program winner (and any travel companion(s) or guest(s)) to sign a liability release, agreeing to release and hold harmless the Military Bowl and affiliated entities, employees, directors, and representatives and all of their successors and assigns from and against any and all claims or liability arising directly or indirectly from the prize and participation in the Program.
- c. If for any reason this Program cannot be executed as planned, including, but not limited to, as a result of infection by computer virus, tampering, unauthorized

intervention, fraud technical failures, or any other causes beyond the control of the Military Bowl that corrupt or affect the security, administration, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of the Military Bowl, or if the Military Bowl is compromised or becomes technically corrupted in any way, electronically or otherwise, the Military Bowl reserves the right to cancel, terminate or modify the Program.

- d. The Military Bowl, in its sole discretion, reserves the right to disqualify any person tampering with the entry process or the operation of the Military Bowl's website. Failure to comply with the rules of the Program may result in a contestant's disqualification and/or forfeiture of any prize or prizes. If the Military Bowl makes a good faith determination that an entrant has cheated or committed fraudulent activity in connection with a Program, the Military Bowl reserves the right to disqualify that entrant from entering and/or winning future Programs and to prosecute and seek damages to the fullest extent permitted by law.
- e. The Military Bowl reserves the right to make changes in the rules of the Military Bowl, including, without limitation, the substitution of a prize of equivalent value, which will become effective upon announcement. If due to circumstances beyond the control of the Military Bowl, any competition or prize-related event or travel is delayed, rescheduled, postponed or cancelled, the Military Bowl reserves the right, but not the obligation, to cancel or modify the Program and shall not be required to award a substitute prize.
- g. The Military Bowl is not responsible for typographical or other errors in the printing, the offering or the administration of the Military Bowl or in the announcement of a prize.
- h.
