Matt Campbell Named Head Coach at Toledo

Matt Campbell became the youngest coach in the FBS at just 32 years of age Friday when he took over the reigns as Toledo's head coach. Campbell was promoted from offensive coordinator, where he was the architect behind the Rockets top ten nationally ranked offense, scoring at a clip of 42.3 points per game. After three years at coordinator, Campbell takes over for former head coach Tim Beckman, who departed to take the head coaching job at Illinois. An Ohio native, Campbell played and coached at Division III powerhouse Mount Union, with a stint at Bowling Green before landing at Toledo in 2008.



Coach Campbell and Coach Calhoun Complete Media Tour

Air Force Coach Troy Calhoun and Toledo Coach Matt Campbell took part in a media tour throughout Washington, D.C. on Tuesday. Each coach did segments on "The Junkies" for 106.7 The Fan, "The Sports Fix" on ESPN 980, WTOP radio, and for The Washington Post. Coach Campbell and Coach Calhoun took part in interviews with Baltimore area media outlets, WNST 1570, WBAL Radio, and 105.7 The Fan. The coaches were in-studio for a segment with WJLA's Tim Brandt, as well as "Washington Post Live" on Comcast SportsNet. The media tour concluded with a reception at Morton's the Steakhouse, where both coaches stressed the importance of recognizing the military through the Military Bowl's partnership with the USO.
